

GRANITE PLANT LAND BOUGHT AT ELBERTON

ELBERTON, Ga., Aug. 20. E. M. McCannless, of Canton, has closed a deal for the purchase of 100 acres of land from Esper E. Hall and 91 acres from Sam W. Thornton and estate. Five thousand five hundred dollars was the price paid for the Hall land and \$2,300 for the Thornton land.

This property is situated in the northwestern suburbs of Elberton and fronts on two of the leading highways and also on the Southern railway on the north and on the Seaboard railway on the south.

The property was bought as a site for a granite manufacturing plant and sheds. It is not far from granite deposits recently purchased by Mr. McCannless from Mrs. Frank Mewhourn and Dr. Chandler for \$8,000 in round figures.

Plans for the erection of suitable buildings on the property just acquired are being prepared.

TRAIN, AUTO CRASH VICTIM NEAR DEATH

GRANTVILLE, Ga., Aug. 20. Carl Attaway, 25, of Grantville, was seriously injured here this afternoon when he was struck by a West Point train as he attempted to drive his auto across a grade crossing. Witnesses said young Attaway, who is employed in a local cotton mill, evidently did not see the train approaching.

He was rushed to the Newnan hospital, where it was said tonight that he had little chance for recovery.
